## **Medicare Policy**

Please be aware that our practice operates on a cash-based payment model, and we do not have a relationship with Medicare. This means that we are unable to provide physical therapy services to clients who have Medicare coverage.

One of the key reasons for this limitation is that, as a provider, we have not opted out of Medicare. Under Medicare regulations, providers have the option to either "opt in" or "opt out" of the Medicare program. "Opting out" of Medicare means that a provider agrees not to submit Medicare claims for any services they provide, and, in return, Medicare beneficiaries are responsible for the full cost of services received from that provider.

However, at Wildflower Physical Therapy & Wellness, we have chosen not to "opt out" of Medicare. This decision is due to several factors, including our focus on providing high-quality care without the administrative complexities and limitations often associated with Medicare billing.

As a result, we want to be transparent with you that we are unable to accept clients with Medicare coverage for physical therapy services. If you currently have Medicare coverage or are considering enrolling in Medicare, we recommend consulting with Medicare directly or seeking guidance from a healthcare advisor to explore your options for physical therapy services.
